REQUEST FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST

1. This request for Expression of Interests follow the General Procurement Notice for this Project that appeared in United Nations Development Business (UNDB) Issue No. **WB1907-04/16 of April 27, 2016.**
2. The **Government of Tanzania** through **Judiciary of Tanzania** has received financing from the World Bank (WB) toward the cost **for implementation of the Citizen-Centric Judicial Modernization and Justice Service Delivery Project** and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.
3. The consulting services (“the Services”) include to: **Review Existing Drawings, Prepare Detailed Design and Cost Estimates, Bills of Quantities (BoQ), Bidding Document, Administration of Bidding Process and Construction Supervision of the Integrated Justice Centers taking into consideration of Environmental Social Management Framework (ESMF) and other fiduciary formalities of land and Environmental Social Safeguards** to at least **six locations of Mwanza, Morogoro, Arusha, Dodoma and in Dar Es Salaam** for the Citizen-Centric Judicial Modernization and Justice Service Delivery Project. **The total duration for the entire assignment should be about Twenty (26) months of which, design should be three (3) months; construction supervision eleven (11) months and 12 months of Defect Liability Period.**

4. The Judiciary of Tanzania now invites eligible consulting firms (“Consultants”) to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The short-listing criteria are: (a) ***Firm’s previous experience in designing and supervision of construction works***, (b) ***Firm’s successful track record for undertaking buildings’ design projects***, (c) ***Availability of appropriate skills among staff*** in similar field.
5. The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to paragraph 1.9 of the World Bank’s *Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits and Grants by World Bank Borrowers*, dated January, 2011 (revised July 2014 (“Consultant Guidelines”), setting forth the World Bank’s policy on conflict of interest.
6. Consultants may associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture or a sub-consultancy to enhance their qualifications.
7. A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Quality-and-Cost-Based Selection (QCBS) method set out in the Consultant Guidelines.
