**ONLINE PETITION FOR MID YEAR ADMISSION AND ENROLMENT  
OF NEW ADVOCATES, 2026**

**Dated this 8<sup>th</sup> April, 2026 at Dodoma,**

This is to inform the legal fraternity and the general public that the Office of the Registrar of the High Court of the United Republic of Tanzania will start receiving petitions for 2026 mid-year admission and enrolment of Advocates from 13<sup>th</sup> April 2026 to 15<sup>th</sup> May 2026.

Persons seeking admission to the roll of Advocates of the High Court are hereby notified to submit their petitions online: -

**A. Petitioners who passed Law School of Tanzania examination must submit the following documents in the order listed below:**

1. Petition.
2. Certified copy of birth certificate.
3. Certified copy of Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE).
4. Certified copy of Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (ACSEE).
5. Certified copy of LL. B Transcript.
6. Certified copy of LL. B Certificate.
7. Certified copy of Postgraduate Diploma in Legal Practice Final Results. (Result Slip/Statement of result)
8. Certified copy of the Certificate for Postgraduate Diploma in Legal Practice.
9. Registered Deed Poll (if there are discrepancies in names).

10. Stamped Certificate of Character from a Senior Practicing Advocate with at least five (5) years of practice or from employer (for those who are employed).
11. Verification of certificates by TCU, NECTA or NACTE (for foreign candidates).
12. Introduction letter from employer (for those who are employed) or from a Senior Practicing Advocate with at least five (5) years of practice.
13. Any other relevant and necessary documents, such as certified copies of the National ID or Diploma certificates.
14. Profile photos (Passport size in court attire) with blue background.
15. Certificate of pupillage/ internship/ externship.

**B. Petitioners who qualify to sit for bar examinations**, must attach a Certificate of Pupilage /Internship/ Externship.

**C. Tanzanian citizens admitted in Zanzibar with five (5) or more consecutive years of experience from the date of Admission must attach;**

1. Petition
2. Admission Certificates
3. Five or more consecutive years' Practicing Certificates.
4. Certificate from Registrar confirming continuous appearance in Zanzibar courts for five consecutive years.
5. Certified copies of academic and professional certificates
6. Certified copy of a National Identity Card.

**Important notice:**

- All petitioners with discrepancies in their names must attach a Registered Deed Poll.
- The Advocate's System for filing petition is accessible through the Judiciary Website at <https://www.judiciary.go.tz>. or directly via <https://ewakili.judiciary.go.tz>.
- The deadline for submission of petitions is **15<sup>th</sup> May 2026 at 00:00hrs midnight**.
- Petitioners whose petitions were previously returned can refile if they meet the above requirements.
